Appointed Board Member Vacancy

The board consists of 4 appointed members and 3 elected members. Each year the term of an elected and an appointed board member ends. (Every three years the term of two appointed board members ends). Appointed board members are chosen by the existing board which looks for skills that complement the other board members. Elected board members may be anyone nominated and voted onto the board by the member clubs at the AGM.

A board member vacancy has arisen and the board wishes to appoint a replacement in time for the July board meeting. This is newspaper advertisement that will be placed next week.

Selection Panel Member

Sportsville Manager

The board has appointed Mike Edmonds as Manager to undertake several projects in partnership with the council, and to achieve other strategic objectives. These projects and objectives are all closely related to Lindvart Park and sport in Kaikohe, and have been funded by the council.

Lindvart Park Project

In the previous FNDC Long Term Plan there was an amount allocated to Lindvart Park for an “increased level of service”. This is council-speak for something that wasn't there before. The council is currently reviewing the LTP and we hope that the money remains in the plan.

We will be starting a consultation process on the assumption that nothing has changed.

We will be looking to use the information that our Facilities Review presented to guide the process which needs to culminate in a recommendation to the council fairly promptly, followed by a design process that can take longer.

We will be talking to a representative from each organisation to start the process followed by a consultation process.
